### **New Patient Registration**

If you would like to register at our Practice please see our website to register or ask at reception for a registration pack. Once completed and returned an appointment may be offered with our Practice Nurse for a New Patient Medical.

### **Named Accountable GP**

From 1 April 2015 all practices are required under the NHS contract to allocate a named, accountable GP to all patients (including children). The named GP will be responsible for your overall care at the Practice; however this does not prevent you from continuing to see any other Doctor or Nurse in the practice. All our patients will be allocated Dr Mugerwa but if you have a preference the practice will make reasonable efforts to accommodate this request.

## Appointments

Routine appointments can be booked in advance and urgent appointments on the day. We also offer Telephone Consultations. Routine pre-bookable appointments are available on Monday and Wednesday evenings. You can book appointments either by contacting the Practice by telephone, or by using our online facility. If you cannot attend an appointment please let us know as this will free an appointment for others to use. Patients can express a preference to consult with a GP of their choice.

## Home Visits

If a home visit is required then please contact the Practice before 11am, when possible. A receptionist will ask you for some further information for the Doctors to consider this request.

## Prescriptions

Medications can be ordered at reception, by online access, post, email or if you are housebound / vulnerable by registering for an order/collection service with a pharmacy of your choice. Please allow a minimum of 48 hours for your prescriptions to be processed.

**Repeat Medication can now be processed through EPS: known as Electronic Prescription Service.** You will no longer need to visit your GP to pick up your repeat prescriptions; your GP will send it electronically to a Pharmacy of your choice. You will need to *nominate* a place for your GP to send your prescriptions, i.e. Pharmacy, or a Dispensing Contractor (if you use one).

## Test Results

Please telephone the surgery after 12pm for your test results. Allow up to 1 week for results to be available. In the meantime, please do not be concerned if the Practice contacts you to book an appointment to discuss the results, this is routine practice procedure. Other results such as X-rays, Ultrasound scans, and MRI scans can take 10 working days.

## Clinics and Services

Services provided by the Practice are New Patient Health Checks (all patients over 5 years old), Minor Surgery, Chronic Diseases, Immunisations, Ear Syringing, Dietary Advice, Well Woman/Man Clinics, Suture Removal and Dressing Clinics, Cervical Smears, Contraception, Pre-conception Advice, and Antenatal/Postnatal Care. This list is not exhaustive. Please enquire for further services available.
